# Message from the Community Spiritual Director Faith and Works

In the movie, The Iron Lady, Meryl Streep plays the role of British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher. Although the following quote cannot be attributed to the Prime Minister Thatcher, in the movie Streep's Thatcher says the following, "Watch your thoughts for they become words. Watch your words for they become actions. Watch your actions for they become habits. Watch your habits, for they become your character. And watch your character, for it becomes your destiny! What we think we become."

It starts with the small decisions. The things we say and don't say. It is those small things that will ultimately define who we are.

I want to share a small portion of John Wesley's sermon The Character of a Methodist: "As he [a Methodist] has time, he 'does good unto all men;' unto neighbors and strangers, friends and enemies: And that in every possible kind; not only to their bodies, by 'feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, visiting those that are sick or in prison;'... but much more does he labour to do good to their souls, as to the ability with God giveth."

Wesley firmly believed that if someone had Christ dwelling within them, a personal transformation would follow. Works of love and service would come forth. Let's look at one of the Articles of Religion for the Methodist church. This is one of our founding documents. I was first appointed to the Agape Chair on the Board of Directors in the Spring of 2017 for three years. I have been the Database Chair for the last three years and Communications/Website/Email Chair for the past two years.

The success, and continued success, of the FVWTE Community depends upon communication within the community.

Ministry Manager is the communication application as directed by the Upper Room. The Upper Room provides the model and direction for our Emmaus walks.

Upper Room launched Ministry Manager Database application 3 years ago. I updated the legacy data from the 14 years of history for the FVWTE members and walks (970 and 36). Ministry Manager has automated many of the processes in our walks. I.E. Personal Profile Updates, Pilgrim payments, the Covenant Letter, Team Selection, Board of Director and Walk history, Mass Messaging emails to name a few.

If you would like to learn more about Board of Directors and are interested in joining please view the Ministry Manager training videos at the bottom of your Ministry Manager dashboard page in the "FAQ" link.

The most important aspect of Ministry Manager is the individual member's capability to update and maintain their personal data for community communication purposes. I.E. name, address, phone numbers, email address, etc. This is a powerful application that allows for the community to communicate securely successfully!

As I step away from the board and "pass the baton" to Siggi Eckhardt I echo the sentiments of Pastor Jim Droste,
